1. Objective

Showcase geothermal projects, sites, and communities through authentic, visual storytelling that links science, technology, and local impact.

2. What to Capture: Photos & Story

Photos:

- Wide shots of the geothermal site or facility (e.g., power plants, drilling rigs, pipelines, hot springs)
- Action shots of workers, engineers, or community members engaged on-site
- Natural landscape or environment surrounding the geothermal site
- Visual details: geothermal steam, instrumentation, monitoring equipment, signage...

3. Short Story Template (150-250 words)

Provide a brief narrative that highlights the context and significance of the project or site.

Suggested structure: ----[Project/Site Name], [Location]

- 3-5 high-quality photos (JPEG or PNG) showing a variety of site perspectives
- Short story document (Word or PDF)
- Optional: Short video clips or interviews (up to 2 minutes)
